This passive solar designed home with an active solar photovoltaic array received a HERS rating of 28, making it 72% more energy efficient. This same M-H Builders home achieved 5-Star certification in the ENERGY STAR for New Homes program, which also requires third-party verification of key energy efficiency components. M-H Builders is an ENERGY STAR Partner.
